20. ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL FOR ELECTRIC CONNECTION TO SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANTS AT SADAR BAZAAR AND RA BAZAAR IN NEW CANTT, ALLAHABAD

Reference Circular Agenda No. 01 dated 10.03.2022.

Board constructed Sewerage Treatment Plants at Sadar Bazaar and RA Bazaar in New Cantt, Allahabad.

In order to operate this STPs, Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL) was requested through Nivesh Mitra portal to carry out joint inspection of the sites and submit a detailed estimate for new electric connection. In view of the above, the concerned G.O. shall be forwarded to the office of the PDDE, Central Command, Lucknow for obtaining necessary sanction.

23. RECOMMENDATION TO PAY THE ENHANCED RATE OF DEARNESS RELIEF TO THE PENSIONERS OF CANTT BOARD ALLAHABAD

27. PERMISSION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF OVER HEAD WATER TANK AT SITE OF EXISTING OVER HEAD WATER TANK IN CHAITHAM LINES CAMPUS OF UNIVERSITY OF ALLAHABAD, ALLAHABAD ON DEFENCE LAND COMPRISING SY. NO. 129/1/2, OLD CANTT, ALLAHABAD

Reference CBR No. 10 dated 30.04.2022.

University of Allahabad, Allahabad vide letter No. R/UE/7454/22 dated 22.03.2022 intimated that University of Allahabad had an Over Head Water Tank at Chaitham Lines Campus for the water supply system. University also stated that due to its dilapidated condition, Over Head Water Tank was a threat to safety of surrounding residents and hence, same was demolished and site was cleared from the debris. To maintain the proper water supply to its campus, University of Allahabad, Allahabad has proposed the construction of new Over Head Tank. Allahabad University also intimated that University Grants Commission, New Delhi has released fund and utilization period of the fund is upto 31.03.2022 and work will be executed by CPWD. Allahabad University has requested to accord permission for construction of Over Head Water Tank at the site of existing Over Head Water Tank.

Site for the proposed construction comprises Sy. No. 129/1/2, Chaitham Lines, Old Cantt, Allahabad. As per General Land Register maintained by DEO Allahabad Circle, Allahabad, the site measuring 47.87 acres comprising GLR Sy. No. 129/1/2, Chaitham Lines, Old Cantt, Allahabad classified as B-3 land described as Hostel, Class Rooms, NCC Military Buildings, Teacher's Quarters situated outside the notified civil area under the management of Defence Estates Officer, Allahabad Circle is held on Perpetuity lease in Schedule XI (modified) of the CLAR, 1937 on annual rent of Rs. 1200/-. Holder of Occupancy Rights is recorded in the name of the University of Allahabad. Site is situated outside notified civil area and placed under the management of Defence Estates Office, Allahabad Circle.

Board vide CBR No. 23 dated 31.03.2022 decided to check sanctioned map to ascertain if over head tank (OHT) was existing prior to its demolition.

In Ordinary Meeting held on 30.04.2022, Board noted that as per records available in the concerned file, no overhead tank was sanctioned by the Board. Board vide CBR No. 10 dated 30.04.2022 decided to ask Allahabad University to provide details of the over head tank for veracity of their claim and subsequently, it should be processed as per rule.

Accordingly, Cantonment Board vide letter No. X-73/Vol. III/CBA/2022/854 dated 27.05.2022 requested University of Allahabad, Allahabad to provide details of the over head tank for veracity of their claim that University of Allahabad had an Over Head Water Tank at Chaitham Lines Campus.

University of Allahabad, Allahabad vide letter No. R/UE/8152/22 dated 27.06.2022 forwarded following documents:

- i. Report submitted by Civil Engineering Department, MNNIT Allahabad regarding dilapidated over head water tank.
- ii. Survey plan of University of Allahabad Chaitham Lines Campus showing the location of over head water tank.
- iii. Minutes of Building Committee Meeting dated 11.06.2010.
- iv. Minutes of Building Committee Meeting dated 21.11.2012.
- v. Letter issued to Executive Engineer, CPWD for demolition of existing over head water tank.

University of Allahabad also stated that the above documents are sufficient for the veracity of their claim that University of Allahabad had an over head water tank at Chaitham Lines Campus. University of Allahabad has requested to accord permission for the c/o Over Head Water Tank at the site of existed Over Head Water Tank, Chaitham Lines Campus to maintain proper water supply to the residents of the campus which comprises of hostels, academic buildings, residential colony etc.

Relevant file is placed on the Table.

Board to consider.

CBR NO. 27: Board considered the letter dated 27.06.2022 of Allahabad University & is of the opinion that the evidences/ documents given by them proves the existence of the Over Head Water Tank. Therefore, the Board decided to permit construction of Over Head Water Tank at site of existing OVER HEAD WATER TANK in Chaitham Lines campus of university of Allahabad, on defence land comprising sy. no. 129/1/2, Old Cantt, Allahabad.

28. KYDGANJ PLOT COMPRISING SY NO. 111/7, FORT CANTT, ALLAHABAD

Reference: CBR No: 27 dated 30-06-2022.

It is informed that tender called vide Advertisement No:T-51/G.S.K.P./2022/CB/ALD/2662 dated 05.07.2022 & corrigendum notice No: T-51/G.S.K.P./2022/CB/ALD/879 dated 13.07.2022 has been cancelled.
