**18. REPAIR OF ROADS IN NEW CANTT, ALLAHABAD**

Reference CBR No. 26 dated 28.03.2023.

Board vide CBR under reference approved the re-carpeting and repair of roads in New Cantt, Allahabad.

In pursuance of the same, Cantonment Board vide letter dated 11.04.2023 directed M/s Mohd Aleem, 18P/8X, Zameer Nagar, Kareli, Allahabad, Contractor of Term Contract for Repair and Maintenance of Roads in Allahabad Cantt for Year 2021-22, to carry out repair of roads in New Cantt, Allahabad.

M/s Mohd Aleem vide letter dated 11.04.2023 intimated that he has already completed the work allotted to him and he has received full payment of the same. He also stated that he could not carry out any new work.

Since, the Work Order issued for Term Contract for Repair and Maintenance of Roads in Allahabad Cantt for Year 2021-22 originally expired on 30.09.2022 and the contractor is not willing to execute the said repair work, Cantonment Board vide letter No. P-II/2021-22/TC/MISC-IMP/CBA/2023/500 dated 15.04.2023 intimated Mohammad Rizwan Contractor, 86, Mahewa East, Naini, Allahabad that Cantonment Board intends to carry out the repair of roads in New Cantt area through his firm under the Tender of Term Contract for Miscellaneous Improvement Works in Allahabad Cantt for Year 2021-22 at the rates quoted by M/s Mohd Aleem, 18P/8X, Zameer Nagar Kareli, Allahabad in tender of Term Contract for Repair and Maintenance of Roads in Cantt Area Allahabad for Year 2021-22 and requested him to convey your agreement for the same for repair of roads in New Cantt.

Mohammad Rizwan Contractor, 86, Mahewa East, Naini, Allahabad vide letter dated 17.04.2023 stated that his firm is agreed to do Road work on the rate of TC Road in Cantt Area for the year 2021-22 in account of above said contract.

In view of the above, Cantonment Board vide letter No. P-II/2021-22/TC/MISC-IMP/CBA/2023/506 dated 17.04.2023 directed Mohammad Rizwan Contractor, 86, Mahewa East, Naini, Allahabad for the execution of the repair of roads in New Cantt as per specifications, terms and conditions laid down in rates in BOQ and Tender of Term Contract for Repair and Maintenance of Roads in Cantt Area Allahabad for Year 2021-22 with date of completion as 31.05.2023.

Accordingly, Mohammad Rizwan Contractor, 86, Mahewa East, Naini, Allahabad has carried out the repair of roads in New Cantt, Allahabad.

**19. NO-OBJECTION CERTIFICATE IN RESPECT OF SY NO. 111/2, KYDGANJ, FORT CANTT, ALLAHABAD.**

Reference Reference CBR No. 26 dated 28.03.2023 and Shri Sunil Kumar & Smt. Geeta Kumari Jaiswal application dated Nil (received in this office on 01/12/2022).

Shri Sunil Kumar & Smt. Geeta Kumari Jaiswal, A/902, Nirala Eden Park, Indirapuram, Ghaziabad- 201 014 (Recorded Holder of Occupancy Rights of Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt, Allahabad) vide application under reference has requested for grant of permission/ NOC for transfer of leasehold rights in favour of Shri Sumit Jaiswal S/o Late Santosh Kumar Jaiswal, 884A/653A, Krishna Nagar, Kydganj, Praygaraj in respect of Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt, Allahabad.

Site is situated inside civil area under the management of Cantt Board Allahabad. Brief history in respect of Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt, Allahabad is given below:

- i. Site admeasuring 4000 sqft comprising Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt was leased out to Shri Kundan Jaiswal in Schedule VI of CLAR, 1925 for residential purpose for a period of 30 years renewable at option of the lessee upto 90 years w.e.f. 26.06.1935.
- ii. First term of lease expired on 25.06. 1965.
- iii. While initiating the proposal for renewal for further term of 30 years lessee had also requested for change of purpose as the site was being used for commercial purposes in violation of condition 1 (6) of the lease. The Cantonment Board vide C.B. Resolution No. 5 dated 25-06-1965 resolved that proposal for renewal of lease and change of purpose be submitted to GOC-in-Chief and accordingly necessary proposal was submitted to HQCC, Lucknow vide Cantt. Board letter No. Y-38/2458 dated 11-08-1965.
- iv. GOC-in-Chief, HQ, Central Command, Lucknow vide letter No.32847-LC3/11 dated 02-09-1968 returned the proposal for its re-submission for fresh lease and accordingly proposal was submitted for two fresh lease in respect of site comprising Sy. No. 111/2 and 111/3 for commercial purposes vide letter dated 21-11-1968.
- v. Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence, New Delhi vide letter No.7/3/L/L&C/69/7828/D (Lands) dated 23.08.1969 had conveyed the sanction of the President to the following measures -
  - a. Grant of lease of 4,000 Sqft of land comprising Sy. No. 111/2 for the purpose of a soap factory to Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VIII CLAR, 1937 with effect from 26-06-1965, on payment of an annual rental of Rs. 120/- and an initial premium of Rs.1840/-
  - b. Grant of lease of 4,000 Sqft. of land comprising Sy. No. 111/3, for the purpose of Plastic factory to Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal in Schedule VIII CLAR, 1937 with effect from 22-06-1965, on payment of an annual rental of Rs. 120/- and a premium of Rs.1840/-.
  - c. Payment of additional rent of Rs.42/- per annum by Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal for the unauthorised use of premises w.e.f. August 1964 to the dates of expiry of the leases in Schedule VI of CLAR, 1925.
- vi. The sanction of the Govt. was communicated to Sri Kundan Lal Jaiswal vide letter dated 09-10-1969, 22-01-1970 and 08-06-1970 vide which he was required to deposit rent and premium as per Govt. sanction amounting to Rs.4937.22 but he had not deposited the rent, premium and made a representation dated 08-07-1970 that he has changed his mind and decided not to use the premises for commercial purposes and requested that lease in respect of site comprising Sy. No. 111/2 be renewed for residential purposes and out of Sy. No. 111/3 an area measuring 1500 sqft be granted for commercial purposes and rest of the area 2500 Sqft for dwelling purposes.



- vii. Accordingly a proposal as requested by the lessee was submitted vide Cantt. Board letter dated 29-10-1971. After a long correspondence, since the change of purposes involved in the subject case was not discontinued after June 1965, the HQ, Central Command (ML&C) letter No. 32847-LC3/63 dated 29-06-1974 directed to ask the lessee to pay the site rent and premium immediately as per sanction of Govt. otherwise a self contained proposal for cancellation of Govt. sanction and resumption of sites may be initiated immediately. Accordingly a letter dated 17-07- 1974 was issued to the lessee for deposit of Rs. 5897.28 as rent up to 1974 and premium as Govt. sanction and after a long correspondence he has deposited all the dues. The lease as sanctioned by the Govt. letter dated 23-08-1969 could not be executed.
- viii. Legal heirs of Shri Kundan Lal Jaiswal, S/Shri Kunwar Narendra Naraiian Singh and Kunwar Arvind Naraiian Singh sons of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal vide letter dated 15.02.2016 requested for mutation of property in their favour, execution of lease as sanctioned by the Govt vide letter dated 23.08.1969 renewal of further term of lease as sanctioned by the Govt vide letter dated 23.08.1969.
- ix. Cantonment Board vide CBR No 1(xxi) dated 17.02.2016 considered the application dated 15.02.2016 of Kunwar Narendra Narain Singh and Kunwar Arvind Narain Singh sons of late Kundan Lal Jaiswal for mutation and renewal of lease In respect of site comprising Sy No 111/2 and 111/3, Kyed Ganj Fort Cantt, Allahabad and resolved to recommend that lease be renewed for final term of 30 years w.e.f. 26.06.1995 to 25.06.2025 in respect of site comprising Sy No 111/2 and w.e.f. 22.06.1995 to 21.06.2025 in respect of site comprising Sy No 111/3, necessary proposal be submitted to competent authority for obtaining necessary sanction for renewal of leases. The Board further resolved to process the cases of mutation by publishing public notice inviting claims and objections within 30 days from publication of notice in local news papers.
- x. No objection and claims were received. Hence, Cantonment Board Allahabad vide CBR No. 11 dated 28.03.2016 resolved that name of Kunwar Narendra Narain Singh and Kunwar Arvind Narain Singh sons of Late Kundan Lal Jaiswal be mutated in respect of site comprising Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj and Sy. No. 111/3, Kydganj and resolved to recommend that leases be renewed for final term of 30 years.
- xi. Cantonment Board vide letter No. T-51/12/VOL.III/JPG/2015-16/255A dated 31.03.2016 requested Directorate, Defence Estates, Central Command that the sanction of competent authority may please be conveyed to the renewal of lease held in Schedule VIII of CLAR, 1937 in respect of site comprising 111/2 w.e.f. 26.06.1995 to 25.06.2025 on payment of annual rent of Rs 180/- and 111/3 w.e.f. 22.06.1995 to 21.06.2025 on payment of annual rent of Rs 180, for further term of 30 years in Schedule IV of CLAR, 1937, under the provisions of existing leases.
- xii. Directorate. Defense Estates, Central Command. Lucknow vide letter dated 27.04.2016 conveyed sanction for renewal of both leases for further period of two tenures of 30 years with effect from 26.06.1995 to 25.06.2025 in respect of Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj and 22.06.1995 to 21.06.2025 in respect of Sy. No. 111/3, Kydganj. Renewal of lease as sanctioned by Directorate. Defense Estates, Central Command. Lucknow vide letter dated 27.04.2016 has not been executed yet.
- xiii. Further, Shri Sunil Kumar vide letter 11.02.2020 requested for mutation in respect of Sy, No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt in favour of Smt. Geeta Kumari Jaiswal and Shri Sunil Kumar.
- xiv. Board vide CBR No. 24 dated 31.03.2022 approved the mutation in favour of Smt. Geeta Kumari Jaiswal and Shri Sunil Kumar in respect of Sy, No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt.

Matter was referred to Board. Board vide CBR No. 28 dated 28.03.2023 decided to take legal opinion regarding transfer of leasehold rights in r/o Sy. No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt, Allahabad based on application of Shri Sunil Kumar & Smt. Geeta Kumari Jaiswal.

Legal opinion has been taken from Cantt Board Legal Adviser, Shri Bal Govind Mishra. Relevant para of Legal opinion dated 27.03.2023 (received in the office on 28.03.2023) of Shri Bal Govind Mishra, Advocate are reproduced below:

”..... आप द्वारा मेरी राय मांगी गई है कि क्या छावनी परिषद द्वारा श्रीमती गीता जायसवाल और श्री सुनील कुमार के हक में परमीशन व अनापत्ति प्रमाण पत्र जारी किया जा सकता है।

इस सम्बन्ध में छावनी परिषद द्वारा अपने पूर्ववर्ती प्रस्ताव द्वारा नामांकन श्रीमती गीता कुमारी व श्री सुनील के हक में किये जाने को स्वीकार किया जाने का उल्लेख किया गया है।

अतएव पट्टाधारक का मात्र (Lease Hold Rights) के रूप में नामांकन किया जा सकता है।.....”

No. 111/2, Kydganj, Fort Cantt, Allahabad from existing Holder of Occupancy Rights to Shri Sumit Jaiswal S/o Late Santosh Kumar Jaiswal, 884A/653A, Krishna Nagar, Kydganj, Praygaraj.**

**20. CENTRALIZED SEWERAGE SYSTEM FOR NEW CANTT AREA: DESIGN/ STRUCTURAL DESIGN, SUPPLY, CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF COMPLETE SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANT OF CAPACITY 2 M.L.D. AND 0.5 M.L.D INCLUDING ALL CIVIL WORKS FOR STPs**

Reference CBR No. 20 dated 26.07.2022 and CBR No. 22 dated 30.11.2021.

Board vide CBR No. 22 dated 30.11.2021 decided to refer the dispute to President, Cantonment Board Allahabad, Sole Arbitrator as per Clause-59 of Contract Agreement dated 30.04.2012 of subject work to adjudicate the dispute that has arisen between Cantonment Board Allahabad and M/s Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd on payment of remaining bill amounts.

As per Clause 59 of Contract Agreement dated 30.04.2012 of the subject work, “ In case of any dispute the settlement of which is not provided under any other clause of this contract it shall be referred to the sole arbitrator, the President, Cantonment Board Allahabad whose decision shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to the contract”.

In view of the above, vide letter dated 02.12.2021, Cantonment Board requested President Cantonment Board to act as a Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the Cantonment Board and M/s Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd on payment of remaining bill amounts and also requested to kindly fix a date for arbitration hearing for early resolution of the subject dispute.

Further, vide letter dated 13.12.2021, Cantonment Board requested M/s Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd to intimate a suitable date for arbitration hearing for early resolution of the subject dispute.

Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd vide letter dated 16.12.2021 (copy enclosed) stated that “President , Cantonment Board Allahabad being appointed as Sole Arbitrator by the Board should not be arbitrator as he himself has signed the agreement dated 30.04.2012., he is one of the parties. Accordingly, he cannot be appointed as Arbitrator as per the Arbitration Act”.

Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd requested to appoint a neutral arbitrator according to Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act.

For early resolution, Cantonment Board vide letter dated 23.12.2021 & 27.12.2021 requested Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd to depute their representative to meet the President, Cantonment Board on 29.12.2021 at the Office of Cantonment Board, 2, Ashoka Road, New Cantt, Allahabad, with all the required documents.

Shri Praveen Kumar Gupta, Senior General Manager (Projects), Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd, Mohali appeared before the President Cantonment Board for the said meeting on 29.12.2021.

Cantonment Board vide letter dated 17.01.2022 intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd, Mohali that since the Contract Agreement dated 30.04.2012 in respect of the subject work was signed by both parties i.e. Cantonment Board Allahabad and Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd, both parties are bound to follow the Terms and Conditions of the said Contract Agreement.

It was reiterated that since, as per Clause 59 of Contract Agreement dated 30.04.2012 of the subject work, “ In case of any dispute the settlement of which is not provided under any other clause of this contract it shall be referred to the sole arbitrator, the President, Cantonment Board Allahabad whose decision shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to the contract”, only the President, Cantonment Board Allahabad can be appointed as Arbitrator in the present case and same was conveyed to Shri Praveen Kumar Gupta, Senior General Manager (Projects), Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd, Mohali during the meeting with President, Cantonment Board Allahabad on 29.12.2021 at Office of Cantonment Board Allahabad.

Cantonment Board Allahabad vide letter P-IV/SEW/S.T.P./CBA/2022/279 dated 17.02.2022 requested Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. to depute their representative to meet the President, Cantonment Board on 28.02.2022 for early resolution of the ongoing dispute at the Office of Cantonment Board, 2, Ashoka Road, New Cantt, Allahabad.

Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. vide e-mail dated 19.02.2022 stated that due to pre-occupancy, our concerned official will not be available to attend meeting with the President at Office of Cantonment Board, Allahabad on the mentioned date i.e. 28.02.2022. and requested to postpone the said meeting and give us some other date, convenient to the President, Cantonment Board. Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. vide e-mail dated 22.02.2022 stated that their concerned official will be available to attend meeting with the President on 03.03.2022.

Cantonment Board Allahabad vide email dated 23.02.2022 requested Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. to depute their Rep to meet the President, Cantonment Board on 04.03.2022

Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. vide e-mail dated 24.02.2022 confirmed that their concerned official will attend the meeting with the President, Cantonment Board on 04.03.2022.

Accordingly, proceedings of Arbitrations was held on 04.03.2022 to adjudicate the dispute between Cantonment Board Allahabad & M/S Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. and based on the hearing, an order dated 04.03.2022 was passed by the Hon'ble Arbitrator.

As directed by the Hon'ble Arbitrator, Cantonment Board released an amount of Rs. 35,00,000/- against the pending R. A. Bill amount to Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. after due approval of the Board vide Circular Agenda No. 01 dated 10.03.2022.

In pursuance of Hon'ble Arbitrator vide Minutes of Arbitration Hearing dated 04.03.2022 instruction to Cantonment Board to look into payment claims of Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd for revamping of E&M equipments, Cantonment Board vide letter No. P-IV/SEW/S.T.P./CBA/2022/492 dated 22.03.2022 scheduled a joint of survey of STPs on 01.04.2022 at 1100 hours to determine the works/ items required for revamping of E&M equipments and requested Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd to depute their Rep for the joint survey of STPs on 01.04.2022 at 1100 hours. However, Rep of Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd was not present for the said survey on 01.04.2022.

Cantonment Board vide letter No. P-IV/SEW/S.T.P./CBA/2023/262 dated 22.02.2023 intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh that Cantonment Board shall only make payment against the pending R. A. bill amount as per the BOQ rates of the subject work. Hence, Cantonment Board released an amount of Rs. 35,00,000/- against the pending Bill to Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. through PFMS (Transaction ID: C032250238868) on 22.03.2022.

Cantonment Board Allahabad also intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh that Cantonment Board could not make any payment for the interest amount and watch and ward charges demanded by the Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd as same are not covered in the Contract Agreement.

Cantonment Board Allahabad also intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh that electricity connection is completed at the STP. It was also intimated that Hon'ble Arbitrator vide Minutes of Arbitration Hearing dated 04.03.2022 instructed Party No. 2 i.e. Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd. to make STP fully functional within one month after completion of electricity connection by Cantonment Board Allahabad.

Cantonment Board Allahabad requested Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh to make STPs fully functional within one month of receipt of the notice.

Cantonment Board Allahabad also intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh that in case Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh fail to comply with this order, commissioning of STPs will be got done through any other agency at the risk and cost of Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh, and the amount so spent shall be deducted from the security deposit, and if the amount so spent falls short from security deposit, the same shall be recovered as per the provisions of Cantonment Act, 2006.

Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh vide letter No. HP-ACBALL/079/L/Reply of Letter dated 16.03.2023 stated that the subject cited work may be treated as completed and under physical possession of Cantt. Board Allahabad.

However, even after lapse of period over a month, Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh have not commissioned the STP and not provided any assurance for commissioning of STPs.

Cantonment Board vide letter No. P-IV/SEW/S.T.P./CBA/2022/492 dated 22.03.2022 intimated Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh that since Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh has willfully not complied with Hon'ble Arbitrator Order dated 04.03.2022, Cantonment Board is going to commission the STPs through any other agency at the risk and cost of Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh and the amount so spent shall be deducted from the security deposit, and if the amount so spent falls short from security deposit, the same shall be recovered as per the provisions of Cantonment Act, 2006.

It is hereby proposed to complete the commissioning of STPs and allied works including house connections under tender of term contract for miscellaneous improvement works in Allahabad Cantt for Year 2021-22.

Relevant file is placed on the table.

Board to consider.

**CBR NO. 20: Board considered & decided that commissioning of STP be carried out through any other agency at the risk and cost of Hydrotech Paryavaran (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chandigarh and the amount so spent shall be deducted from the final payment, and if the amount so spent falls short from security deposit, the same shall be recovered as per the provisions of Cantonment Act, 2006.**

**Further, Board decided to complete the commissioning of STPs and allied works including house connections under Tender of Term Contract for miscellaneous improvement works in Allahabad Cantt for Year 2021-22.**

**21. PROCUREMENT OF FURNITURE AND OF ELECTRIC EQUIPMENTS FOR CANTT BOARD SCHOOLS.**

During periodic survey of Cantonment Board School, it is observed that the existing furniture in the classrooms is in poor condition. It is also observed that there is an urgent requirement of procurement of furniture, electrical items and repair/maintenance of water cooler for smooth functioning of the School. Estimated cost of the same is Rs. 20,32,000/-. Details of the estimates are given below:-

Akbar Road (from Ashoka Road to Church) comprises Sy. No. 195, New Cantt, Allahabad. As per the GLR maintained by DEO Allahabad Circle, Sy. No. 195 is Class 'C' (Road) land vested to Cantonment Board.

Board to consider.

**CBR NO. 22: Board considered & approved the provision of Guard Room at Akbar Road, New Cantt, Allahabad.**

**23. SHIFTING OF EXISTING WATER PIPELINE NEAR OHT IN R.A. BAZAR, NEW CANTT, ALLAHABAD.**

For shifting of the boundary wall for proposed expansion of R.A. Bazaar Public School, existing water pipeline near OHT needs to be shifted. Estimated cost of shifting the water pipeline to new location is amounting in Rs. 4,35,000/-.

Administrative approval of the Board is solicited for shifting of the water pipeline near OHT in R. A. Bazaar, New Cantt, Allahabad.

**24. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT FOR SUPPLY OF MANPOWER/WORKER FOR DEFENCE ESTATES OFFICE, ALLAHABAD.**

Reference, DEO Allahabad letter No. DEO/ADM/Hiring/Man Power/2022-23/III dated 22.03.2023.

Vide letter under reference DEO Allahabad intimated that contract/ agreement between this office and Cantonment Board, Allahabad for supply of manpower is expiring on 31.03.2023 and since the manpower/ worker is further required to be engaged, wef 01.04.2023, agreement of supply of manpower / worker of 12 Nos. is to be done w.e.f. 01.04.2023 onwards upto 31.03.2024.

DEO Allahabad has requested to process the mater.

**25. AGREEMENT FOR PAYMENT OF SERVICE CHARGES TO CANTONMENT BOARD ALLAHABAD AND NORTHERN RAILWAYS, LUCKNOW DIVISION**

Cantonment Board vide letter dated 12.01.2023 forwarded a copy of draft agreement to DRM Northern Railways, Lucknow Division for approval and also requested to pay the amount of service charges of Rs. 33,07,81,503.55.

Northern Railways, Lucknow Division vide letter dated 15.02.2023 raised following points and requested to submit revised service charges bill after corrections:

- A. Total area of land has been taken in calculation of service charges without deduction of land area of track, circulating area, roads, playground, forest etc (on which public has right of way).
- B. Total area of building is different as measured by Railways
- C. Building cost has been taken without depreciation of building cost minimum 2% depreciation each year.

In order to resolve the issue, a joint site inspection of Sy. No. 96, Old Cantt, Allahabad was carried out on 01.03.2023 and 02.03.2023 by Rep of Cantonment Board and Northern Railways, Lucknow Division.

Based on the site inspection report, guidelines prescribed in MoD (DG, DL&CS) letter No. 9/5/C/L&C/72/Vol.II dated 21.05.1984 and discussions held between Cantonment Board and Northern Railways, Lucknow Division, Cantonment Board vide letter dated 29.03.2023 raised a revised demand of service charges amounting to Rs. 22,40,65,676/- for period w.e.f. FY 1982-83 to FY 2022-23.

An agreement has been signed between Cantonment Board Allahabad and Northern Railways, Lucknow Division on 30.03.2023 for payment of service charges amounting to Rs. 22,40,65,676/- for period w.e.f. FY 1982-83 to FY 2022-23 and for payment of service charges in future as & when they fall due in respect of Sy. No. 96, Old Cantt, Allahabad.

It is intimated to the Board that the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh renamed both Allahabad District and Division as Prayagraj District and Division. Further, Allahabad Railway Junction has been renamed as Prayagraj Junction.

It is hereby proposed to the Board to consider and recommend renaming Allahabad Cantonment as Prayagraj Cantonment to the relevant competent authorities for the following reasons:

- i. As Allahabad district has been renamed as Prayagraj and Allahabad Railway Junction has been renamed as Prayagraj Junction., it is a natural course of action for the Cantonment to follow suit in alignment with the recent changes.
- ii. This shall enable Allahabad Cantonment to avail funds and other benefits under various centrally sponsored schemes, State schemes and various infrastructure projects meant for up-gradation of Prayagraj District overall.
- iii. This shall enable Allahabad Cantonment to better integrate with in the overall scheme and vision for Prayagraj as Major tourist destination in near future.
- iv. This shall provide Allahabad Cantonment a better visibility and footprint on religious and spiritual tourist circuit of India.
