Board vide CBR No. 15 dated 13.12.2023 decided to issue notice to Shri Naresh Chandra Agrawal S/o Shri Radhey Shyam, Bungalow No. 10, Sy. No. 211, Cariappa Road, New Cantt, Allahabad to show cause within 14 days of receipt of the notice as to why action under the provisions of Cantonments Act, 2006 should not be taken against him for removal of above mentioned constructions.

Accordingly, Cantonment Board Allahabad vide letter No. Z-104/CBA/2024/182 dated 15.02.2024 directed Shri Naresh Chandra Agrawal to Show Cause within 14 days as to why action under the provision of Cantonment Act, 2006 shall not be taken against him for removal of above mentioned construction.

Shri Naresh Chandra Agrawal vide letter dated 27.03.2024 submitted his reply to the Show Cause Notice. Reply of Shri Naresh Chandra Agrawal is reproduced below:

- “...1. That the Site Inspection Report and Site Plan attached along with your above referred Show Cause Notice shows 13 rooms as unauthorized construction in the land at 10, Cariappa Road, Survey No. 211, New Cantt. Allahabad.*
- 2. That most of the alleged unauthorized constructions are quite old, may be more than 20- 30 years.*
- 3. That one room at the outhouse of the bungalow No. 10, Cariappa Road, Allahabad, marked as "A" by me in your site plan attached with your Show Cause Notice dated 15 February, 2024, is already the subject matter of your Show Cause Notice dated 26 April, 2023 claiming it to have been constructed by me unauthorisedly. In response to that I have submitted my reply dated 23rd May, 2023 and a composition application dated 14 August, 2023. No decision has yet been conveyed to me on my this composition application and therefore, present reply to your Show Cause Notice dated 15 February, 2024 does not cover this room/structure.*

4. *That most of the alleged unauthorised constructions, except one mentioned in the Paragraph 9 below, have been constructed by the outsiders who made encroachments in the land of Bungalow No. 10, Cariappa Road, Allahabad. The legal heirs are neither related to most of them nor do they have any control over them.*
5. *That all the legal heirs of Late Mr. Radhey Shyam Agrawal and residents of 10, Cariappa Road, Allahabad are senior citizens aged between 67 and 79 years. They are invalid and suffering from various serious diseases.*
6. *That, any action by legal heirs to remove / demolish these alleged unauthorised constructions would lead to serious quarrel, unrest and law and order problem in the area. It may also pose life threat to the heirs of Late Radhey Shyam Agrawal who are residing at 10, Cariappa Road, Cantt. Allahabad.*
7. *That under these circumstances legal heirs are not in a position to remove these encroachers from the property nor are they in a position to demolish the alleged unauthorised constructions.*
8. *That any action by Cantonment Board, Allahabad for removal / demolition of the alleged unauthorised constructions, would not be opposed by the legal heirs.*
9. *That there is one room measuring 19'11"x 16'6" near the main building at 10, Cariappa Road, Allahabad (Photograph attached) and shown as unauthorised construction in your site plan attached with your show cause notice dated 15 February, 2024. It has been marked for identification as "B" by me in your this site plan. This room / structure is regularly used by us and thus, its demolition would cause genuine hardship to us. It is therefore, prayed that same is not demolished and a sum as the Board thinks reasonable by way of composition under Section 248 (1) of the Cantonments Act, 2006 may be accepted from me.*
10. *That an application for aforesaid composition is being filed separately praying for composition of the alleged unauthorised construction under Section 248 (1) of the Cantonments Act, 2006.*
11. *That in view of above, it is requested that no action be taken against me under the provisions of the Cantonments Act, 2006"*

Shri Naresh Chandra Agrawal vide another letter dated 27.03.2024 has requested for composition of the unauthorized construction.

Ministry of Defence vide letter under reference has conveyed the sanction of President of India for grant of Working Permission to Prayagraj Development Authority for Widening, Strengthening and beautification of existing road from IERT Puliya to Bank of River Ganga on defence land measuring 3600 sqm out of GLR Survey No. 149-154 (B4;Cantt Board Management) at Baghara, Old Cantt, Allahabad on the basis of creation of Equal Value Infrastructure (EVI) amounting to Rs. 7,89,33,600/- in lieu of defence land.

Working permission to Prayagraj Development Authority on defence land measuring 3600 sqm valued at Rs. 7,89,33,600/- is on basis of creation of EVI, which shall accrue to the Cantonment Board Allahabad.

It is submitted that Director, PPP Model vide letter cited under reference has stated that in the event of signing of MoU between ECHS Polyclinic Prayagraj & Cantonment Board Allahabad, 10 % of the total revenue generated via ECHS Home Sample Collection Project scheme shall be shared with Cantonment Board Allahabad as royalty fee. Other expenses such as free of cost transportation/operational cost etc shall be beared by the PPP Director.

Board to consider.

CBR NO. 32: Board considered & approved that 10 % of the total revenue generated via ECHS Home Sample Collection Project scheme shall be shared with Cantonment Board Allahabad as royalty fee once the MoU is signed.

33. RUNNING/MANAGING OF BLOOD BANK IN CANTT GENERAL HOSPITAL

34. INITIATION OF BVOC (BACHELOR OF VOCATION COURSES) AT CANTONMENT GENERAL HOSPITAL, PRAYAGRAJ

The UGC-BVoc scheme has been introduced in India by The University Grants Commission as a means to advance undergraduate vocational education and promote skill development and institutions like our own could prove to be high value assets in this programme. Through specialized vocational training, CG Hospital Prayagraj will bridge the gap between traditional academic programs and industry demands.

The revenue generated via said project will be disbursed among the PPP Partner and Cantonment Board as per the pre-laid tender rules of 38%-62% revenue sharing.

It shall be relevant to mention that the staff required to serve as the teaching faculty for the institution (PG Doctors, Doctorate of Medicine holders, etc.) are already working on the payroll of CG Hospital Prayagraj and the hospital management possesses their absolute support which ensures seamless execution of the project.

Board to consider.

CBR NO. 34: Board decided to conduct a presentation on BVoc (Bachelor of Vocation Courses) at Cantonment Board, Allahabad for further action.

Kalpana, In-charge Vicker Public School (VPS) in matters related to Mid-Day Meal scheme (MDM), Entrance Examination for children, irregular attendance, pressuring teachers to perform task other than teaching etc. On the basis of information received, the competent authority vide office order No.165 Part I dated 08.05.2024 attached Smt Kalpana, In-charge, VPS in Cantt Board office and handed over the temporary charge to Shri Mohd Ansar, Principal, RAB Public School. It is further submitted that competent authority formed a preliminary inquiry committee comprising Shri Mohd Ansar, Principal, RAB Public School & Shri Adesh Mishra, Junior Assistant. After submission and perusal of preliminary inquiry report, the competent authority issued show cause notice vide letter No. Admin/VPS/Inquiry 2024/CBA/2024/685 dated 17.05.2024 to Smt Kalpana, in-charge Vicker Public School. Smt. Kalpana vide letter dated Nil submitted her clarification which was found unsatisfactory.

The matter is placed before the Board for initiating disciplinary action against Smt. Kalpana.
