**13. PAYMENT OF WAGES TO COACH FOR RUNNING BOXING ACADEMY.**

Board vide Circular Agenda No. 01 dated 10.08.2022 and CBR No. 6 dated 31-08-2022 to hired a coach for Boxing Academy training of students at honorarium of Rs. 7000/- per month with 50% of the fee collected as incentive for good performance.

It is pertinent to mention that boxing coach have to work beyond their duty hours as well as they have to work on holidays in light of the administrative exigencies. Presently, the wages drawn by the data coach is Rs.7,000/- per month. Therefore it is proposed that the Boxing Coach shall be paid lump-sum amount of Rs.10,000/- per month instead of previous salary of Rs.7,000/- plus 50% of the fee collected.

Reference CBR No. 42 dated 26.02.2024.

Cantonment Board vide CBR No. 42 dated 26.02.2024 resolved to develop new vending zones on the land under management of Cantonment Board inside the Allahabad Cantonment.

In reference to street vending, legal opinion was sought from Cantt Board Legal Adviser, Shri Satish Kumar Rai and Shri Satish Kumar Rai vide his legal opinion stated that Street Vendors Act, 2014 has “overriding effect” over Cantonments Act 2006 and Cantonment Property Rules, 2017 as per Section 33 of Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.

In connection to the same, Cantonment Board identified a defence land pocket near Polo Ground comprising Sy. No. 326, New Cantt, Allahabad classified as ‘C’ Land under the management of Cantonment Board. The said pocket is isolated vacant plot without any permanent boundary wall and hence, it is highly vulnerable to encroachment as unauthorized vendors have cropped up due to the proximity with the Hon’ble High Court.

In connection to the identified land near Polo Ground, it is also intimated that Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence, Dte Gen DL&C, New Delhi vide letter No. 708/7/L/L&C/82 dated 06.12.1983 conveyed the sanction of the President for withdrawal of an area of 48,751.50 sq.ft out of Sy. No. 326 and change of purpose/ allotment of separate survey numbers in respect of the said area of 48,751.50 sq.ft on payment of annual rent i.e. Sy. No. 326/1 with area of 26251.50 Sq.ft. for Shopping Complex and Sy. No. 326/2 with area of 22,500.00 Sq.ft. for cinema.

In view of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Defence sanction for change of purpose to commercial purpose in respect of the identified land near Polo Ground and in pursuance of CBR No. 42 dated 26.02.2024, Cantonment Board has established Street Vending Zone on defence land under the management of Cantonment Board near Polo Ground.

In pursuance of Section 3 (1) of the Street Vendors Act, 2014, a biometric survey, form filling, photography and data entry & compilation with SQL Server of all existing street vendors was carried out by Kiran Software near Polo Ground within the area under the jurisdiction of Cantonment Board.

It is highlighted that the vending zones will strictly be regulated as per the provisions of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014. It is also pertinent to mention that the vending rights given to vendors will be strictly as per the Street Vendors Act, 2014 which does not give any rights over the Class ‘C’ land. Moreover, Section 29 (1) of the Street Vendors Act, 2014 itself secures the right of the Cantonment Board to vacate the defence land in case the land is required for any other purpose as directed by MoD. Hence, the question of permanent occupancy and rights over the defence land does not arise. Also, it has become obligatory over Cantonment Board, being a Municipal Body, to develop vending zones and regulate the street vending as Section 36 (1) has given one year period to implement the Street Vendors Act, 2014.

As per Section 22 (1) of Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014, a Town Vending Committee was constituted by this office for Vending Zone on Sy. No. 326 near Polo Ground, New Cantt, Allahabad.

A meeting of the said Town Vending Committee in connection to the Vending Zone on Sy. No. 326, New Cantt, Allahabad was held in this office on 24-08-2024.

Minutes of the Meeting are reproduced below:-

बैठक में अधिशासी अधिकारी द्वारा पूर्व में बसाये गये विजय बाजार के बारे में विस्तार से चर्चा किया गया और उस बाजार से जनता और पथ विक्रेता को मिलने वाले लाभ का विस्तार से विवरण दिया गया। टाउन वेंडिंग कमेटी के समक्ष विजय मार्केट के आधार पर ही इस नये बाजार बसाये जाने का प्रारूप रखा गया। टाउन वेंडिंग कमेटी को नये बाजार बसाये जाने हेतु डिटेल्ड इम्प्लीमेंटेशन प्लान प्रेजेन्टेशन के तौर पर दिखाया गया। कम्पनी द्वारा प्रेजेन्टेशन में बाजार बसाने हेतु स्थल क्षमता सर्वेक्षण व योजनाकार की मदद से विक्रेता बाजार का सम्पूर्ण नियोजन व पारदर्शिता के साथ नक्शे का वृहद विवरण पेश किया गया। योजना अनुसार इस बाजार में कुल 234 पथ विक्रेताओं को दुकान (सुपर स्ट्रक्चर साईज 12 फीट गुणा 10 फीट) देकर पुनर्वासित किये जाने का प्रस्ताव पेश किया गया। इस बाजार में पूर्ण रोशनी की व्यवस्था, 24 पीस सी0 सी0 टी0 वी0 कैमरा, हाई कोर्ट और ड्रमण्ड रोड की तरफ से वाहन पार्किंग, 40 पेड़, एक वाटर हार्वैस्टिंग सिस्टम, दो पार्किंग का बोर्ड, दो पैलून, तीन परगोला सेड, जनता के आने जाने हेतु 12 से 15 फीट तक पब्लिक मूवमेन्ट एरिया, दो शौचालय, बाजार में पानी पीने की व्यवस्था, स्मार्ट कार्ड और वेंडिंग सार्टीफिकेट देकर बाजार बसाने का प्रस्ताव और प्रस्तुतिकरण पेश किया गया।

कम्पनी द्वारा व्यवसाय के अनुसार अलग अलग जोन निर्धारित किया गया जिसके लिए सभा में उपस्थित लाभार्थियों से विचार विमर्श के साथ साथ सहमति ली गई। लाभार्थियों द्वारा बाजार क्षेत्र का डेवलपमेन्ट एवं दुकान का रंग रूप, आकार प्रकार और दुकान की कीमत रु.3,50,000/- (तीन लाख पचास हजार मात्र) पर सहमति जताई गई।

जो लाभार्थी दुकान की खरीददारी हेतु सक्षम नहीं हैं उनको बैंक के माध्यम से प्रधानमंत्री मुद्रा योजना के तहत ऋण उपलब्ध कराये जाने की बात टी0वी0सी0 के द्वारा कही गई।

समिति के सभी सदस्यों के द्वारा दुकान आवंटन में लाटरी की प्रक्रिया को पारदर्शिता बनाये रखने के लिए वीडियोग्राफी और शांति व्यवस्थ रखने हेतु पुलिस बल का होना जरूरी बताया और साथ ही पुलिस अधिकारी द्वारा पुलिस बल भेजवाये जाने पर सहमति जताई गई। सभा में बैठे पत्रकार द्वारा टायलेट और पार्किंग की व्यवस्था को सुविधाजनक बनाये जाने हेतु जोर दिया गया। एडिस्नल डी सी पी पुलिस द्वारा बाजार में प्रत्येक दुकान पर व्यवसाय के अनुसार लाभार्थी का नाम, फिंगर नम्बर का बोर्ड लगाने का प्रस्ताव रखा गया। बैठक में शामिल लाभार्थियों ने अपने व्यवसाय के अनुसार दुकान (सुपर स्ट्रक्चर) की खरीददारी और बाजार के विकास में खर्च हेतु उनके तरफ से लगाया गया धनराशि देने में स्वेच्छा से सहमति जताई।

बैठक में समिति सदस्यों के द्वारा बसाये जा रहे बाजार और दुकान के निर्माण कार्य की प्रगति और गुणवत्ता पर संतोष जाहिर किया।

### टाउन वेंडिंग कमेटी द्वारा लिया गया निर्णय:-

1. बाजार का नाम: जगदीश मार्केट समर्पित स्व0 मेजर जगदीश चन्द्र वर्मा। बाजार स्थल पोलो ग्राउण्ड बाउन्ड्री और गौवर्नमेन्ट प्रेस के बीच की जमीन पर, कैन्ट बोर्ड लैण्ड सर्वे नम्बर 326।
2. विक्रेता प्रमाण पत्र (लाइसेन्स) व स्मार्ट आई डी कार्ड की अवधि: जारी होने की तारीख से पाँच वर्ष तक के लिए मान्य होगा।
3. विक्रेता प्रमाण पत्र (लाइसेन्स) व स्मार्ट आई डी कार्ड का नवीनीकरण पाँच वर्ष के बाद उस समय की टाउन वेंडिंग कमेटी के निर्णय के पश्चात लिया जायेगा।
4. मासिक शुल्क रु.3000/- प्रति लाभार्थी।

Treated water of 2.00 MLD STP at Sadar Bazaar, New Cantt, Allahabad can be reused for following purposes:

- a. Rejuvenation of McPherson Lake in New Cantt
- b. Treated water can be applied to ground, plants, trees, etc. in Gaddha Ground, Cantt Schools and Cantt Hospital

For recycling the treated water, it is proposed to supply the treated water from exit point of 2.00 MLD STP upto RA Bazaar source drain of McPherson Lake with intermittent connections at Cantt Schools and Cantt Hospital by laying a network of pipeline and allied civil works. Estimated cost of laying network of pipeline and allied civil works is Rs. 35,00,000/-.

**26. DEVELOPMENT OF ENFORCEMENT FLEET AND PROCUREMENT OF VEHICLES FOR SANITATION UNDER THE ALLOTMENT OF SHARE OF REVENUE (15<sup>TH</sup> FINANCE COMMISSION)**

To consider the development of enforcement fleet and procurement of vehicles for sanitation under the allotment of share of revenue under 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission.

For enforcing municipal regulations in the Cantonment area, a consistent mechanism equipped with Surveillance system is required to be developed as the visible enforcement vehicles can act as a deterrent to unauthorized activity in the Cantonment area. The Enforcement Fleet will help in early detection of unauthorized land activities, rapid response in the complaints received and deterrence to discourage individuals from engaging in illegal land activities. The establishment and effective operation of an enforcement fleet can lead to several benefits in terms of revenue generation by efficient collection of tax, imposing fines/ challans on the offenders etc. a well-developed enforcement fleet can contribute significantly to the overall enhanced functionality of this office, promoting public safety, regulatory compliance and positive community engagement.

**27. RE-CONSTRUCTION OF DRAIN STARTING NEAR ALIMENTO RESTAURANT AND ENDING AT AMBEDKAR CHOWK, SADAR BAZAAR, NEW CANTT**

Reference Registrar General, Allahabad High Court letter No. 6218/REGR.(P) dated 13.08.2024.

Registrar General, Allahabad High Court vide letter No. 6218/REGR.(P) dated 13.08.2024 intimated that Hon'ble Mr. Justice Samit Gopal, Judge Allahabad High Court is residing at B-205, Sterling Apartment, Muir Road, Prayagraj. Behind the residence of His Lordship, there is an uncovered Sewer Drain/ Canal, thereby emitting foul smell and becoming a place for breeding of mosquitoes. This is posing a grave threat to the life of residence of the aforesaid locality. In view of the above, the Hon'ble Judge has desired that necessary instructions may be issued to the officials concerned, to cover the aforesaid Sewer Drain/ Canal, in order to avoid any health concerned issues to His Lordship and family and also to the other residents of the locality. He also requested to kindly take necessary action in this regard at the earliest.

Survey of the said drain has been carried out and the said drain starts near Alimento and ends at Ambedkar Chowk, Sadar Bazar, New Cantt and comprises Sy. No. 88/250 and 88/249 which are under the management of Cantonment Board Allahabad. Existing drain is in dilapidated condition and re-construction of drain is necessary for covering the drain.

Estimated cost of re-construction of the subject drain is amounting to Rs. 99.51 Lacs.

The drain has been projected under AMRUT for finance as it is a fresh work & will require special Grant-in aid if built through MoD Budget.
