6. WIDENING, STRENGTHENING AND BEAUTIFICATION OF RAINA ROAD FROM MAZAR CHAURAHA TO OFFICE OF BOTANICAL SURVEY OF INDIA.

Tender for Widening, Strengthening and Beautification of Raina Road from Mazar Chauraha to Office of Botanical Survey of India was invited vide tender notice Advt. In reference to Prayagraj Mela Authority letter No. 2618/fifteen-MKM-2025(2024-25) dated 23.08.2024, committee gone through the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017. As per Rule173 (xx) of GFR, 2017, “Lack of competition in rule 173(xix) shall not be determined solely on the basis of the number of Bidders. Even when only one Bid is submitted, the process may be considered valid provided following conditions are satisfied: (a) the procurement was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids. (b) the qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive; and (c) prices are reasonable in comparison to market values.”

In the present case, the tender was uploaded on e-procurement portal and Notice Inviting Tender was also published in two daily newspapers and on the official website of Cantonment Board. Further, Notice Inviting Tender was also forwarded to Prayagraj Mela Authority and Executive Engineer, Construction Division-IV, UPPWD, Prayagraj. Tender was uploaded on e-procurement portal on 25.09.2024 and last date for submission of bid was 04.10.2024. Hence, tender was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids. Further, qualification criteria was not unduly restrictive.

In view of the above and since the subject project is critical for Mahakumbh-2025 and time left for completion of the work is very short, Tender Opening Committee comprising Assistant Engineer (PWD), Office Superintendent, Assistant Engineer, Junior Engineer, Store keeper and Computer Programmer opened the bid on 05.10.2024 and admitted the following bid for technical evaluation. M/S Mohd. Aleem, contractor has quoted lowest tender of **Rs. 1,50,20,344/-** which is below the estimated cost of **Rs. 154.80 Lacs.**

As per Para No. 11.8 (Rejection of Single Bid) (pp.09) of Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Procurement Policy Division, New Delhi letter No. F.1/1/2021-PPD dated 29.10.2021, “It has become a practice among some procuring entities to routinely assume that open tenders which result in single bids are not acceptable and to go for re-tender as a ‘safe’ course of action. This is not correct. Re-bidding has costs: firstly the actual costs of re-tendering; secondly the delay in execution of the work with consequent delay in the attainment of the purpose for which the procurement is being done; and thirdly the possibility that the re-bid may result in a higher bid.”

Lack of competition shall not be determined solely on the basis of the number of Bidders. Even when only one Bid is submitted, the process should be considered valid provided following conditions are satisfied:

- i. the procurement was satisfactorily advertised and sufficient time was given for submission of bids;
- ii. the qualification criteria were not unduly restrictive; and
- iii. prices are reasonable in comparison to market values.”

In view of the above, current tendering process be considered valid as the above mentioned three conditions are duly satisfied in this tender.

Also, there is an urgent need for repair & maintenance in Cantt. Board Hall as it is in poor condition. Therefore, it is estimated that Rs. 39.50 lakhs will be required for it.

11. PROCUREMENT OF MAHINDRA & MAHINDRA UTILITY VEHICLES (V2) PICK UP VEHICLES FOR SANITATION UNDER THE ALLOTMENT OF SHARE OF REVENUE (15TH FINANCE COMMISSION)

Reference: CBR No. 26 dated 31-08-2024.

Procurement of "Mahindra & Mahindra Utility Vehicles" (V2) Pick up called through Gem Portal. The cart has been added and the actual procurement cost increased by Rs.26,220./-. The Board has passed total Rs. 7,00,000/- for procurement of said vehicles but the actual cost of complete project is Rs.7,26,220/- in GeM Portal.

12. PROCUREMENT OF 01 NO. INNOVA CRYSTA FOR CANTT. BOARD, ALLAHABAD (15TH FINANCE COMMISSION)

Administrative approval of Board is to given for procurement of one Toyota utility vehicle Manual Two wheel drive Toyota (Innova Crysta) for Cantt. Board Allahabad from Cantt Board fund at the Estimated cost of Rs. 20,00,000/-.

The Govt. Vehicle Ciaz VXI make model January, 2015 (UP70 AG1749) is to be replaced by above mentioned vehicle The old vehicle is about to complete 10 years in the month of December, 2024 & has completed 1,80,000 km. approx. The said vehicle is not in good condition. Therefore repair cost is increasing. The vehicle will be eligible for BER in 2025.

Mahakumbh- 2025 is going to start from the month of January, 2025 in which VIPs will visit the Mahakumbh-2025 through Cantonment Board Allahabad. This Innova Crysta can be utilized for VIP travel thereby saving cost on hiring of vehicles & will also create a permanent asset for Cantt. Board.

Provision for procurement of Innova Crysta has already been made in budget 2024-2025. Even in the case of non sanctioning of budget, funds are available in CFC non tied budget. The expenditure will be booked against the regular budget if sanctioned or else through CFC untied funds.

Approval of Board is hereby asked for the purchase of vehicle.

For promoting shooting sport, it is proposed to establish indoor shooting range for Air Rifle/Air Pistol at Cantt. High School, Sadar Bazar, New Cantt, Allahabad.

Estimated cost of establishment of indoor shooting range for Air Rifle/Air Pistol at Cantt. High School, Sadar Bazar, New Cantt, Allahabad is Rs. 23,68,000/-.
